

**Non-Tenure Track Lecturer, Department of Public Administration
The University of Texas at San Antonio**

The Department of Public Administration at The University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA) invites applicants for a full-time non-tenured Lecturer position beginning Fall 2009 (pending budget approval). The appointment will last one year with a possible renewal after the year's completion.

The required qualifications to be considered are a strong record of professional experience in the public or non-profit sector and a master's degree in Public Administration, Political Science, Urban Planning or related discipline for appointment at the rank of Lecturer. Preferred qualifications include work experience in Urban Planning and/or Nonprofit Management and university teaching experience. Responsibilities include teaching three courses per semester and service to the Department, College, and UTSA. The person hired will also have student advising commitments. Teaching will be at the graduate and/or undergraduate level. Courses will be offered primarily at the UTSA Downtown Campus but may also be offered at the 1604 Campus and primarily at night. The Department currently offers a NASPAA-accredited Master of Public Administration (MPA) degree and an undergraduate minor in Nonprofit Management. The department provides American Humanics certification both at the graduate and undergraduate level.
